REPORT u/Sec.12(1) OF KARNATAKA LOKAYUKTA ACT 1984

Sub:- In the matter of redressal of grievance of the complainant
Sri.M.Manjunath s/o Munegowda, Kodalahatti village,
Hunasemaranahalli post, Jala hobli, Bengaluru North taluk – reg.

This complaint is filed by Sri.M.Manjunath s/o Munegowda, Kodalahatti village, Hunasemaranahalli post, Jala hobli, Bengaluru North taluk, (hereinafter referred to as 'Complainant' – for short) against 1)Tahsildar, 2) Executive Officer of Taluk Panchayath and 3) Panchayath Development Officer of Hunasemaranahalli Gram Panchayat, Bengaluru North Taluk (hereinafter referred to as 'respondents no.1 to 3, respectively – for short). He had filed a complaint in the prescribed Form No.1 & 2 and which is in conformity with Rule 4 of Karnataka Lokayukta Rules 1985, for the grievance that, respondents no.1 to 3 have created hakku patras in favour of some persons in respect of Sy.No.103 of Kodalahatti village of Hunasemaranahalli Gram Panchayat in Bengaluru North taluk and committed dereliction of duty.


2. As contemplated u/Sec. 9(3)(a) & (b) of Karnataka Lokayukta Act 1984, the respondent no.1 to 3 were called upon to file their comments. In the comments, the respondent no.1 has stated that, during the year 1998-99 and 2002, certain extent of land in Sy.No.103 of Kodalahatti village was carved of and sites were formed. Hakku patras were issued to houseless persons.

They have constructed houses and they are living in the houses. Certain litigations are pending in the Court of Devanahalli in relation to allotment of sites. Further, unauthorized occupants have filed applications for regularization of their unauthorized occupation under Akrama-Sakrama Scheme. The Gram Panchayat has taken action to prevent further unauthorized occupation in the remaining extent of land. Gram Panchayat has passed resolution to grant two acres of land in Sy.no.103 for Solid Waste Management Unit (Verming Compost) and letter was addressed to Deputy Commissioner.

3. When the rejoinder was called by the complainant, but he has not submitted his reply.
4. On the available records it is found that, the grievance of the complainant in this regard is well founded that, certain extent of land in Sy.No.103 of Kodalahatti village was carved of and sites were formed. It is necessary to take appropriate action against the encroachers and also prevent further encroachment of Government land bearing Sy.no.103 of Kodalahatti village, Hunasemaranahalli Gram Panchayat, Bengaluru North taluk. It is hereby recommended under Section 12(1) of Karnataka Lokayukta Act 1984 to redress the grievance of complainant as stated supra within **three months** from the date of receipt of this recommendation and the intimation as to further action in the matter be sent to this authority.
