**REPORT U/S 12(1) OF THE KARNATAKA LOKAYUKTA ACT,
1984**

Sub: For taking action against the persons
who are in illegal occupation of the
houses constructed by the Karnataka
Slum Development Board -reg.


1. Complainant Smt.Subhadra w/o.Murthy, No.35, KSRP Quarters, 1st Cross, 3rd Block, Karumariyamma Temple, Kudlu Slum Quarters, Bengaluru (hereinafter referred to as Complainant) has filed complaint alleging that 24 families were residing in slum of Koodlu in Sy.No.148 who are below poverty line and they are not having any houses . But Slum Development Board (Board, for short) has demolished 24 houses in which said families were residing promising them that houses will be constructed for them in the same place. Slum Development Board has constructed houses in the same place but, it has allotted the houses to other persons.

2. Sri.N.Mohan, Executive Engineer has submitted comments stating that 104 (G) houses were to be constructed under NURM – BSUP Project in Sy.No.148 of Koodlu and 96 (G) houses have been constructed. 73 families of Geddalahalli Slum have been shifted to 73 houses out of 96 houses constructed in Koodlu in Sy.No.148. For remaining 31 houses, beneficiaries have been identified in the meeting of the Board. 20 houses have been occupied illegally by 20 families without allotment and the said families have filed applications to the Board several times to allot the houses in

which they are residing along with D.D. and D.D. have been returned to them all the times as they are not entitled for allotment. There are no documents/information to show that said 20 families who are in illegal occupation were residing earlier in the said place.

3. Though it is reported by the Executive Engineer that 20 families are in illegal occupation of 20 houses, the concerned authorities have not taken action to evict the said 20 families who are in illegal occupation of the houses, this report is made under Section 12(1) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act to the Government to direct the concerned Competent Authorities to evict the 20 families who are in illegal occupation of the houses.

4. The Competent Authority shall take steps to implement this report within a period of one month from the date of this report and shall submit action taken report in this regard as provided under Section 12(2) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act.
