**REPORT U/S 12(1) OF THE KARNATAKA LOKAYUKTA ACT,  
1984**

Sub: For taking action to clear the shops  
constructed over evening bazar street  
situated at Ward No.91, Bharatinagar

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1. On the anonymous complaint alleging encroachment of road in ward No.79, report was called from Executive Engineer, Shivajinagar Sub Division. Executive Engineer has submitted report dt:24.06.2015 which has been signed by Executive Engineer, Assistant Executive Engineer and Assistant Engineer. Their report is that footpath which is by the side of evening bazaar and palace mall have been encroached and notices have been issued to clear the encroachment. On the basis of the report of, suo-motu investigation has been taken up u/s 7(2) of Karnataka Lokayukta Act against (1) Executive Engineer, Shivajinagar Sub.Division, BBMP, Bengaluru and (2)Asst.Executive Engineer, Shivajinagar Sub.Divn, BBMP, Bengaluru (hereinafter referred as Respondent Nos.1 and 2 respectively).
  2. Report was called for form Respondents about the steps taken to clear the encroachment.
  3. Assistant Executive Engineer has submitted report dt: 30.11.2015 stating that the owners of the shops who have encroached the road are very poor and the local corporator has written letter dt: 19.11.2015 to the Joint Commissioner, BBMP,

- Mayo Hall to regularise the shops and collect rent from the occupants of the shops.
4. Report was called for from Joint Commissioner, BBMP, Mayo hall to state about the action taken on the report of Executive Engineer dt: 24.6.2015.
  5. Addl. Commissioner, BBMP has submitted report dt: 28.1.2017 stating that there is no impediment to clear the shops constructed over evening bazaar road. That there is no provision to regularise the shops which are constructed over evening bazaar road and action will be taken in accordance with law.
  6. In spite of reminder letter to the Joint Commissioner, BBMP, Mayo hall to submit the report on the action taken to clear the shops constructed over evening bazaar road, no reply/report is submitted by Joint Commissioner, BBMP.
  7. In view of the above, this report is made under Section 12(1) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act to the Government to direct the authorities concerned to clear the shops constructed over evening bazaar road, Ward No.91, Bharatinagar.
  8. The Competent Authority shall take steps to implement this report within a period of one month from the date of this report and shall submit action taken report in this regard as provided under Section 12(2) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act.
