**REPORT U/S 12(1) OF THE KARNATAKA LOKAYUKTA ACT,
1984**

Sub: For taking action to cancel the allotment
of sites to beneficiaries in Sy.No.11 of
Lakshmipura Village, who were not
who were entitled for the allotment
of sites under Ashraya Scheme - reg


1. An investigation was taken up by invoking section 9 of Karnataka Lokayukta Act on the basis of complaint filed by Sri.Ananda Murthy K.B. s/o Ballanajanappa, Kebbepalya Village, Chikkabanavara Post, Bengaluru(herein after referred as Complainant for short) against 1) Executive Officer , Yelahanka, Bengaluru North Taluk, 2) Panchayath Development Officer, Somashettyhalli Grama Panchayath, Chikka Banavara, Bengaluru and (3) Tahasildar, Bengaluru North Taluk, Bengaluru (herein after referred to as Respondent No.1 to 3 respectively) alleging that they have committed misconduct.
2. According to the Complainant the Respondents had distributed sites under Ashraya Scheme in Sy.No.11 of Lakshmipura Village to the persons who were not entitled for the benefit.
3. Response was sought from the Respondents and they have denied the allegations made in the complaint. They have stated that there were 225 sites formed in Sy.NO.11 of Lakshmipura Village within the limits of Abbigere Panchayath which is

presently called Somashettihalli Panchayath. That the beneficiaries were selected in Grama Sabha held on 14.7.2006 by Abbigere Grama Panchayath and the list prepared in the Grama Sabha has been approved by Rajiv Gandhi Housing Corporation and after receiving the list from Rajiv Gandhi Housing Corporation, resolution has been passed on 26.6.2012 to allot the sites and accordingly sites were allotted.

4. A careful examination of the records including documents produced by the PDO show that the beneficiaries at Sl.No.1 to 8 and Sl.No.10 to 15 in Annexure-II to the report of PDO are not residents of the Lakshmipura Village.

6. In view of the above, this report is made under Section 12(1) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act to the Government to direct the authorities concerned to cancel the allotment to beneficiaries of sites in Sy.No.11 of Lakshmipura Village who were not entitled for the allotment of sites under Ashraya Scheme.

7. The Competent Authority shall take steps to implement this report within a period of one month from the date of this report and shall submit action taken report in this regard as provided under Section 12(2) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act.
