**REPORT U/S 12(1) OF THE KARNATAKA LOKAYUKTA ACT,
1984**

Sub: For taking action to stop the illegal
mining being carried on, in Sy.No.293 of
Balakundi Village, Hunugund Taluk
Bagalkot District by M/S.JEM
Company-reg.


Complainant Sri. Parashurama Lakshmanna Neelanaik, Sector No.49, Plot No.121, Navanagar, Bagalkot District (hereinafter referred as Complainant) has filed complaint alleging that Respondent-Dy.S.P, of Karnataka Lokayukta at Bagalkot is not taking action against Jem Mining Company which is carrying on illegal mining activities, though he has been informed personally and through organisation about illegal mining.

2. Dy.Commissioner was called upon to submit the report. He has submitted letter with the survey report and sketch prepared by DDLR, ADLR and J.E. of Mines and Geology. The sketch and report show that mining has been carried on in an extent of 15 acres 28 guntas in Sy.No.293 beyond the land leased for mining and mining is carried on in an extent of 5 acres 13 guntas in Sy.No.296/1A and granite waste has been dumped in Sy.No.291 and 292.

3. Dy.Commissioner, Bangalore Urban District was called upon to submit report on the Complaint. Dy. Commissioner has submitted reply stating that it is decided to hold enquiry in the matter and enquiry has been fixed on 31.10.2014. That the case has been transferred on 3.2.2015 to Spl.D.C.-1 for deciding the case and he has issued notice to the parties fixing the date for enquiry on 18.4.2016.

4. Since the materials on record and survey sketch and report prepared by D.D.L.R. and A.D.L.R and the J.E. disclose that the Jem Company has carried on mining in an extent of 15 acres 28 guntas in Sy.No.293 which is beyond the area leased in favour of Jem Company, this report is made under Section 12(1) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act to the Government to direct the concerned Competent Authorities to take action against illegal mining by Jem Company in accordance with law.

5. The Competent Authority shall take steps to implement this report within a period of six months from the date of this report and shall submit action taken report in this regard as provided under Section 12(2) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act.
