



INTRODUCTION

As required under sub-section (6) of Section 12 of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act, 1984 (Lokayukta Act), this annual consolidated report on the functioning of the Lokayukta and Upalokayukta is presented. This 22nd Annual Consolidated report pertains to the financial year 2007-08 i.e. for the period from 1st April 2007 to 31st March 2008 and it refers to the functions performed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice N.Santosh Hegde, Lokayukta and Hon'ble Mr. Justice G. Patri Basavana Goud, Upalokayukta for the said period.

2. The general perception about the institution of Lokayukta is that it is an organization meant for preventing or fighting corruption in public administration. This may be due to the fact that the Institution of Lokayukta is the successor to earlier two institutions namely, Anti Corruption Bureau and its successor Vigilance Commission, which were constituted for the limited purpose of preventing corruption in public administration. But the institution of Lokayukta is created on the recommendations of the First Administrative Reforms Commission headed by late Mr. Morarji Desai. The Report is of the year 1966, which recommended constitution of State Level Ombudsman like institution to be named as "Lokayukta" and at the centre, institution called "Lokpal". But for a long period of time, this recommendation of the first Administrative Reforms Commission did not find favour with the Central Government or State

Governments. It is for the first time, by a Bill of 1984, the State of Karnataka provided for creation of a Lokayukta Institution and which Bill became enactment and came into force on 15th January 1986. The object of the institution was primarily to oversee good governance, including prevention of corruption, nepotism and arbitrariness in public administration, in the State of Karnataka. The provisions in the Lokayukta Act are substantive when compared to the provisions found in some other States, where such Law was enacted subsequently. 22 years have gone after the enactment of this Act in the State of Karnataka and today this Institution has earned substantial praise from the public at large in its functioning, both in the field of fighting corruption, as well as in the field of monitoring good administration.

3. The Lokayukta Act provides that the Lokayukta or the Upalokayukta depending upon their allotted jurisdiction can question the arbitrary acts on the part of the public servants and even initiate prosecution in cases where criminal offences are found to have been committed by public servants. The Institution of Lokayukta, therefore, is an independent forum available to public through which they can effectively ventilate the grievances against administration and obtain redressal of their grievances. It can also by way of recommendation to Government suggest remedial actions in suitable cases. If allowed to function independently this Institution can become an effective watch dog against injustice being caused to the citizens and monitor state actions towards the ideals of welfare State.

4. While Lokayukta Police independently act under the Prevention of Corruption Act, the Institution of Lokayukta deals

with redressal of the grievances of the public, besides taking action on corrupt public servants.

5. Having realized that one of the prominent shortcomings in the public administration is lack of access to aggrieved persons to meet the concerned public servant and seek redressal, the Lokayukta and Upalokayukta have tried to solve this problem in the functioning of the Institution of Lokayukta. In this regard, the Lokayukta and Upalokayukta visit District Head Quarters periodically and meet people by prior intimation and hear their grievances and try to solve such grievances at the spot itself in the presence of the District Officers/officials to a large extent and those which require further investigation are brought to the head quarters and are enquired into with the assistance of the judicial officers who are on deputation in the Institution of Lokayukta. Since, practically it is not possible for the Lokayukta and Upalokayukta to visit every Taluk and villages, Lokayukta Superintendent of Police in every District have been advised to visit a taluk atleast once a month and thereafter, the villages to the extent possible after giving due notice to the public so that grievances of such rural people and redressed, if possible, with the assistance of local officials and if not possible to forward the same to the headquarters, from where such grievances would be enquired into.

6. Since this type of public meeting does not help in cases of emergency, a helpline termed as 24x7 helpline with phone number 15320 for calls from land line and 1800425320 for calls from Mobiles has been installed in the Lokayukta headquarters at

Bangalore, which is serviced by the Lokayukta officials throughout the day and night. The officials in this system have been provided with Additional phone line and computer with all information about the roads in Karnataka, hospitals at different regional levels, police stations with their phone numbers, so that public in Karnataka who are deprived of health facilities in the hospitals and assistance in police stations could contact this number and the person manning the helpline could immediately address the police station or the hospital concerned and contact the officials there, so that help is made available to the needy immediately. All conversations in this helpline system is recorded, so that that there will be no complaints against the assistance that is sought and rendered. This system was inaugurated by His Excellency, the Governor of Karnataka on 25th March 2008 and has become very popular.

7. Apart from the above, provisions is also made to access the status of the complaints given to the Lokayukta through website, which also gives next date of hearing, stage at which the complaint is pending. The website address is www.lokayukta.kar.nic.in. Further, by those who would not like to disclose their identity or names while giving complaints and information to the Lokayukta police regarding amassing of wealth by public servants, the above website can be made use of where facilities are made to furnish such information and such information could be accessible only by the Lokayukta and the Chief of the Lokayukta Police and none else, so that confidentiality is maintained.

8. By the passage of time and innovations made by the concerned authorities in their acts of misdeeds as also by virtue of

certain decisions of the superior courts, Lokayukta Act requires certain immediate amendments. Such amendments have been recommended to the Government and the same is pending before the Government. The proposed amendments are annexed to this report.

9. Since the kind of complaints received in the Institution are such as not being possible to be investigated only by the officers of judiciary, police, engineering or state accounts, who are on deputation to this institution, the services of Sri.K.R.Chamayya, former Vice-Chairman, KAT; Sri.M.D.Singh, IPS, former DG & IGP of Karnataka State; Sri.D.N.Munikrishna, former Inspector General of Police and former Member of the Karnataka Public Service Commission; Sri.K.L.Anande Gowda, former Director of Town Planning are utilised under Section 15(3)(b) of the Lokayukta Act and all these services are purely honorary to help the people coming to this institution with their complaints/grievances. In addition, the services Sri Somashekaraiiah, former Special Deputy Commissioner; Dr.Balasubramanyam of Swami Vivekananda Youth Movement, Dr.R.Chandrashekara, former Vice Chancellor of Rajiv Gandhi University, Dr.Hanumanthappa, Dr.Srinivasamurthy and Dr. Kamath of Health Foundation, Bangalore, have been utilised in the investigation of individual cases. It would be appropriate to place on record the services rendered by them to this institution.

10. In spite of the above, because of passage of time and increase in volume of work this institution suffers from lack of human resources, as also some infrastructural requirements. Requests made in this regard have been pending with the Government.

11. The year 2007-08 has been particularly a year of testing time for the institution of Lokayukta. The Lokayukta police with their limited resources have excided all expectations by making a record in their fight against corruption. They deserve a line of praise in this report. With more hands made available, I am sure this wing of Lokayukta can do wonderfully well in fighting corruption. Even in the area of grievance redressal, public have become aware of the assistance that could be rendered by the institution of Lokayukta which has been receiving complaints from far off districts also. However, in this area also for want of human resources, the work load has increased tremendously, so much so, we have about 20,000 cases pending investigation or enquiry.

12. The Government of Karnataka vide its Govt. Order No. CI 164 MMM 2006 dated 12/3/2007 referred the a matter under Section 7(2A) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act, 1984 in respect of the illegal mining activities carried in the State of Karnataka, particularly in the Districts of Bellary, Chitradurga, Tumkur and Bangalore Rural Districts for the period from 2000 to 2006. Voluminous records and documents are collected from various State and Central Government Departments during the course of the said enquiry. In view of the fact that the investigation involved certain technical matters pertaining to various aspects of mining, it was felt necessary to seek assistance of persons who had the knowledge of mining, Forests and laws concerned with forest and mining. In this regard, the services of Sri K.R. Chamayya, Former Secretary to Government, Department of Law and Parliamentary Affairs, (2) Dr. U.V. Singh, IFS, Conservator of Forests; (3) Sri R.L. Gaikwad, Retd. Dy. Director of Mines and Geology; (4) Sri A.

Basavaraj, Retd. Dy. Director of Mines and Geology; (5) Sri K.C. Subhash Chandra, Retd. Sr. Geologist of Mines and Geology; (6) Sri H.N. Venkatesh Murthy, Retd. Superintendent, Forest Department; (7) Sri Udayakumar, Regional Director, Environment, Department of Forests and Ecology, Belgaum; (8) Dr. M.H. Balakrishnaiah, Director, Karnataka State Remote Sensing Applications Centre, Bangalore; and other officers and officials.

13. Lokayukta and Upalokayukta have conducted number of meetings with officers of various departments of Government and have suggested systemic changes for good governance and redressal of grievances of the public and for prevention of illegalities or irregularities being committed by public servants, and so also with regard to the actions to be taken by the public servants, to prevent loss of revenue to the State Exchequer, were utilized the institution.

14. After the present Lokayukta assumed the office of the Lokayukta, a new dimension was given to transparency in public life by setting an example by publishing the Assets and Liabilities of Lokayukta, Upalokayukta and other officers of Lokayukta in the Website of Lokayukta. The Lokayukta has also impressed that all the public servants must publish their Assets and Liabilities on the website for bringing about transparency in public administration and thereby ensure good governance.

15. The submission of Assets and Liabilities Statement of MLAs and MLCs under Section 22 of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act is strictly implemented. It is remarkable achievement in the functioning of the Lokayukta that because of the strict

implementation of the Act, all the public servants who are Members of Legislature have submitted their Assets and Liabilities for the year 2006, which they were not doing during earlier years.

16. The details regarding the Complaints under the Karnataka Lokayukta Act, Enquiries under the Karnataka Civil Services (C.C & A) Rules, 1957 and Investigations under the Prevention of corruption Act, and cases handled by technical wing of the Institution are brought in detail in the subsequent chapters.

INVESTIGATION OF COMPLAINTS UNDER
THE KARNATAKA LOKAYUKTA ACT

I) Miscellaneous complaint cases

According to the provisions of Karnataka Lokayukta Act, 1984 (Lokayukta Act) every complaint should be supported by Form No.1, the complaint and Form No.II the complainant's affidavit. Whenever complaints are filed without Form No.I and II, if the address of the complainant is available, Form No.I and Form No. II would be sent to them for compliance. All anonymous petitions and pseudonymous petitions coming within the jurisdiction of Hon'ble Lokayukta have to be closed since the Lokayukta has no suo-motu power of investigating the complaints. Even in such cases, the matter will be referred to the Police Wing if the same could form a basis as source information for their action under the provisions of Prevention of Corruption Act, if there is a prima facie case in that regard. Even such anonymous or pseudonymous complaints having prima facie case would be placed before Hon'ble Upalokayukta in regard to public servants coming within the jurisdiction of Hon'ble Upalokayukta for taking suo-motu action, if necessary. In all miscellaneous cases wherein the complainant complies with Form No.I and Form No. II, such of those miscellaneous cases would be registered as a complaint. The statements of miscellaneous cases are as below.

The above statement depicts that during the year 2007-08 totally 1331 miscellaneous complaints have been disposed and out of which 231 complaints have been regularly registered since the complainants have later sent the complaints in Form No.1 and II. In 366 complaints suo-moto actions have been initiated. In 428 complaints which are anonymous/pseudonymous, 108 complainants have not sent Form No.I & II, even though they were asked to submit the same. 198 complaints could not be entertained under the Lokayukta Act and they are closed. Further no miscellaneous complaints are pending at the end of the year.

II) Complaints with Affidavit

The complaints which are filed along-with duly filled in form No.I, complaint and supported by Affidavit in Form-II, which are in accordance with the Karnataka Lokayukta Act and Rules have been registered and each complaint will be given a distinct number through the computer. Every such complaint will be initially scrutinized by the Scrutiny officers i.e. Addl. Registrars of Enquiries, Deputy Registrars of Enquiries, Asst. Registrars of Legal Opinion and the Public Prosecutor, to whom the complaints have been distributed district-wise. These officers will also

assist the Hon'ble Lokayukta and Hon'ble Upalokayukta in the investigation of these complaints under Sec.9 of the Lokayukta Act. The Lokayukta/Upalokayukta will also get the complaints investigated through the Technical Wing or the Police Wing of the Lokayukta organization. Further, the Hon'ble Lokayukta / Upalokayukta may utilize the services of other State Government Servants or Central Government officers on the permission of that Government or any other agency for investigation of the complaints, under Sec. 15(3) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act.

2) Where the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta proposes, after making such preliminary enquiry, as he deems fit to conduct any investigation under the Lokayukta Act, the copy of the complaint will be sent to the public servant concerned and the competent authority and such public servant will be given an opportunity to offer his comments on such complaint.

3) If the complaint is frivolous or vexatious or is not made in good faith or there are no sufficient grounds for investigating or, as the case may be, for continuing the investigation; or other appropriate remedies are available to the complainant, the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta will communicate the reasons for the closure of the case both to the complainant and the public servant.

4) Further, the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta cannot conduct any investigation under the Lokayukta Act in case of complaints involving grievance in respect of any action specified in Schedule -II, namely,

- a) Action taken for the purpose of investigating crimes relating to the security of the State.

- b) Action taken in the exercise of powers in relation to determining whether a matter shall go to a court or not,
- c) Action taken in matters which arise out of the terms of a contract governing purely commercial relations of the administration with customers or suppliers except where the complainant alleges harassment or gross delay in meeting contractual obligations.
- d) Action taken in respect of appointments, removals, pay, discipline, superannuation or other matters relating to conditions of service of public servants but not including action relating to claims for pension, gratuity, provident fund or to any claims which arise on retirement, removal or termination of service.
- e) Grant of honours and awards.

Further, the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta cannot investigate any complaint involving grievance if the complainant has or had, any remedy by way of appeal, revision, review or other proceedings before any tribunal, Court, or other authority and has not availed of the same.

5) The Lokayukta/Upalokayukta for the purpose of any investigation (including preliminary enquiry before such investigation) under the Lokayukta Act, if necessary will summon relevant documents and witnesses and record evidence.

6) If the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta is satisfied that the action of the public servant has resulted in unjust or undue hardship to the complainant or to any other person, a report will be sent to the Competent Authority under Section 12(1) of the Lokayukta Act recommending that such injustice or hardship shall be remedied or redressed in such a manner and within such time as may be specified in the report and the Competent Authority shall within one month of the expiry of the period

specified in the report, intimate the Lokayukta the Upalokayukta the action taken on the report under Section 12(2) of the Lokayukta Act.

7) If the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta is satisfied that an allegation is substantiated either wholly or partly, a report will be sent to the Competent Authority under Section 12(3) of the Lokayukta Act, recommending warranted action and such Competent Authority shall within three months of the date of receipt of the report, intimate the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta the action taken or proposed to be taken on the basis of the report under Section 12(4) of the Lokayukta Act.

8) If the Lokayukta/Upalokayukta is satisfied with the action taken or proposed to be taken on the recommendation or findings under Section 12(1) or 12(3) of the Act, case will be closed under Section 12(5) of the Act, under information to the complainant, the public servant and the competent authority concerned; but where he is not so satisfied and if he considers that the case so deserves, he may make a special report to His Excellency the Governor of Karnataka under Section 12(5) of the Act and also with information to the Competent Authority concerned and the Complainant.

9) The statements and details regarding the complaints received, disposed of and pending for the year 2007-08 are furnished herein below.

ENQUIRY CASES

CASES REGISTERED UNDER PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION ACT

5

Apart from investigation under Karnataka Lokayukta Act, the Police officers deputed to Karnataka Lokayukta institution are vested with powers to register and investigate the cases under the provisions of Prevention of Corruption Act.

(i) Whenever the Public servant possesses assets disproportionate to his known sources of income and if there is any information or a complaint in this behalf, the definite sources will be collected discreetly by the Police of Karnataka Lokayukta and a case will be registered under Sec.13(1)(e) read with Sec.13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1984 and raid will be conducted to unearth the valuables and assets such as gold, cash and other movable and immovable properties.

(ii) Whenever a public servant demands for himself or for any other person any valuable thing or pecuniary advantage as a motive or reward for showing official favour without any public interest by abusing his position as a public servant, and if there is a formal complaint in this behalf by the complainant before the Police, a case will be registered under Sec.7 and 13(1)(d) read with Sec.13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1984 and a trap will be laid by the Police. If the suspected public servant accepts the bribe by handling the currency notes, then he will be caught red handed.

(iii) Further, the Lokayukta Police, on the basis of the credible information of misappropriation of funds or irregularity will register the case under Section 13(1)(c) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 and the case will be investigated.

(iv) Other than raid and trap cases under the Prevention of Corruption Act 1984, there are also other cases handed by the Police, entrusted to them for preliminary investigation under the Karnataka Lokayukta Act.

(v) After investigation of the cases registered under the Prevention of Corruption Act, if prima facie case is made out against the erring public servants, they will be prosecuted in the Court of Law. As per Sec.19 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, the Disciplinary Authority has to accord sanction for prosecuting the public servants, after applying its mind to the facts and circumstances of the case. Therefore, the Police, after investigation will send a report to the Disciplinary Authority along with all relevant materials and evidence collected during the course of investigation for according such Prosecution Sanction Order. On according the prosecution sanction, Charge sheet will be filed before the Court of Law for prosecuting the accused. If on investigation, no case is made out against the accused, a report will be submitted to the competent Court of Law, for closure of the FIR already submitted to the Court.

**AMENDMENTS PROPOSED TO THE KARNATAKA
LOKAYUKTA ACT, 1984**

1) Amendment of Section 2.- In the Karnataka Lokayukta Act, 1984 (Karnataka Act 4 of 1985) hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act) in section 2,-

(1) for clause (1), the following shall be substituted, namely,-

“(1) “action” means administrative action taken by way of decision, recommendation findings or in any other manner, willful failure or omission to act or any conduct amounting to criminal misconduct in accordance with sub-section (1) of section 13 of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 (Central Act 49 of 1988) and all other expressions relating to such action shall be construed accordingly.”

(2) in clause (12) in item (e), after the words “a statutory body” the words “including a society owned or controlled by the State Government” shall be inserted;

(3) in clause (13), for the words “means a Secretary” the words “means the Chief Secretary, an Additional Chief Secretary, a Principal Secretary, a Secretary, or a Secretary-II ” shall be substituted.

2. Amendment of section 3.- In section 3 of the Principal Act,-

(1) in the heading, for the word “Appointment” the words “Constitution of Lokayukta Institution and appointment” shall be substituted;

(2) in sub-section (1), for the words and punctuation “the Governor shall appoint a person to be known as the Lokayukta and one or more persons to be known as the Upalokayukta or Upalokayuktas” the words, figure, brackets and punctuation “there shall be constituted an institution to be known as the Karnataka Lokayukta which shall consist of a person to be known as the Lokayukta and one or more persons to be known as Upalokayukta or Upalokayuktas, appointed as such by the Governor and such other officers and employees referred to in sub-sections (1) and (3) of section 15. The Lokayukta shall be the Head of the Karnataka Lokayukta” shall be substituted;

(3) after sub-section (3), the following shall be inserted, namely:-

“(4) In all suits and other legal proceedings by or against the Karnataka Lokayukta the pleading shall be signed and verified by and all process in such suits and proceedings shall be issued to, and be served on, the Registrar of the Karnataka Lokayukta.”

3. Amendment of section 7.- In section 7 of the Principal Act for Sub-section (1), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the Lokayukta may investigate any action which is taken by or with the general or special approval of, any public servant, in any case where a complaint involving a grievance or an allegation is made in respect of such action or “such action can be or could have been,, in the opinion of the Lokayukta, recorded in writing, the subject of a grievance or an allegation.”

(2) in sub-section (2),-

(i) for the words “other public servant referred to in sub-section (1)” the words “any other public servant holding a post or office carrying either a fixed pay or remuneration of more than rupees twenty thousand or a pay scale the minimum of which is more than rupees twenty thousand as may be revised by the Government from time to time, in consultation with Lokayukta.” shall be substituted;

(ii) after the words “opinion of the Upalokayukta”, the words “recorded in writing” shall be inserted;

(3) in sub-section (4), after the words and figures, “sub-sections (1) to (3)” the words “when the office of an Upalokayukta is vacant by reason of his death, resignation, retirement, removal or otherwise or” shall be inserted;

(4) after sub-section (4), the following shall be inserted, namely:-

“(5) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-section (1) to (4) the Lokayukta may,-

(i) if an Upalokayukta so desires in writing, withdraw at any stage a complaint or an investigation pending before

that Upalokayukta, for investigation by himself or by the other Uplokayukta, if any;

(ii) for reasons to be recorded in writing, transfer at any stage a complaint or an investigation pending before him to an Upalokayukta for disposal and notwithstanding anything contained in sub-sections (1) and (2) that Upalokayukta may dispose of that matter:

Provided that nothing in this sub-section shall be construed as empowering the Lokayukta or Upalokayukta to revise or review any decision, finding or recommendation recorded earlier by the Upalokayukta or Lokayukta, as the case may be."

4. Amendment of section 8.- In section 8 of the Principal Act, in sub-section (2),-

(i) in item (c), for the word "six" the word "twelve" shall be substituted;

(ii) in item (d), for the word "five" the word "seven" shall be substituted.

5. Amendment of section 9.- In section 9 of the Principal Act,- (1) after sub-section (1), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided that in case of a grievance, if the person aggrieved is dead or for any reason, unable to act for himself, the complaint may be made or if it is already made, may be prosecuted by his legal representatives or by any other person who is authorized by him in writing in this behalf."

(2) in sub-section (3),-

(i) in clause (a), after the word "complaint" the following shall be inserted namely:-

"and in the case of an investigation initiated suo-motu by him, the opinion recorded by him to initiate the investigation under sub-section (1) or (2), as the case may be, of section 7,"

(ii) in clause (b) after the word "complaint" the word "or opinion as the case may be" shall be inserted.

(3) after sub-section (7), the following shall be inserted, namely;-

"(8) (a) If, during the course of preliminary inquiry or investigation under this Act, the Lokayukta or Upalokayukta is prima facie satisfied that,-

(i) the grievance in respect of any action is likely to be sustained either wholly or partly, he may, forward an interim report to the Competent Authority, recommending grant of interim relief to the complainant or that the grievance complained of, shall be redressed expeditiously or both; or

(ii) the allegation in respect of any action is likely to be sustained either wholly or partly, he may, forward an Interim Report to the competent authority recommending to take such action as may be considered necessary by him against a public servant, including his suspension, if he is a public servant falling under item (d) or (g) of clause (12) of section 2, pending enquiry or investigation.

(b) A copy of the recommendation made under clause (a) shall be sent to the complainant."

(9) The Lokayukta or Upalokayukta may visit office of any public servant other than the office of the Chief Minister, Minister or a member of the Karnataka State Legislature to further the purposes and object of this Act."

6. Amendment of section 11.- In section 11 of the Principal Act.- (1) in sub-section (1), after the words "Lokayukta or an Upalokayukta" the words and figures "or others whose services are utilized under sub-section (3) of section 15 and specially authorized by the Lokayukta in this behalf" shall be inserted;

7. Amendment of section 12.- In section 12 of the Principal Act,-

(i) in sub-section (1) the following shall be inserted at the end, namely:-

“and send a copy of the recommendation to the complainant.”

(ii) in sub-section (6), for the words “his functions and that of the Upalokayukta” the words “the Karnataka Lokayukta” shall be substituted.

8. Amendment of section 13.- In section 13 of the Principal Act, in sub-section (1) after the words “accept or reject the declaration” appearing at two places, the words “after giving an opportunity of being heard” shall be inserted.

9. Amendment of section 14.- In section 14 of the Principal Act, for the words “into any complaint” the words “under this Act by” shall be substituted.

10. Amendment of section 15.- In section 15 of the Principal Act,-

(1) in sub-section (3) in clause (b), for the words “any other agency,” the words “any person or any other agency” shall be substituted;

(2) in sub-section (4), in the proviso, after the words “Provided that” the words “when the office of the Lokayukta is vacant by reason of his death, resignation, retirement, removal or otherwise or” shall be inserted.

(3) after sub-section (4) the following sub-section shall be added, namely-

“(5) The Lokayukta may give directions and exercise superintendence over the functioning of the police officers working in his office, in so far as it relates to the investigation of offences alleged to have been committed under the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 (Act 49 of 1988) or an offence with which a public servant may be charged under the Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 (Central Act 2 of 1974) at the same trial.

Provided that while exercising the powers of superintendence or giving directions under this sub-section the Lokayukta shall not exercise powers in such a manner so as to require those police officers to investigate or dispose of any case in a particular manner.”

11. Amendment of section 22.- In section 22 of the Principal Act, (1) in sub-section (1), for the words and figures “before 30th June” the words and figures “on or before 30th June” shall be substituted.

(2) for sub-section (2) the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely.-

“(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Karnataka Minister’s salaries and Allowances Act, 1956 (Karnataka Act 5 of 1957) and Karnataka Legislature Salaries, Pension and Allowances Act, 1956 (Karnataka Act 2 of 1957), but without prejudice to the provisions of sub-section (2), no public servant referred to in sub clauses (a) to (c) of clause (12) of section 2, who fails to submit a statement of his assets and liabilities as required under sub-section (1) shall be eligible and entitled for any salary, allowance and other monetary benefits as admissible to him under the said enactments from the date of publication of his name under sub-section (2) till he submits such statement.

12. Insertion of section 22A.- After section 22 of the Principal Act, the following section shall be inserted, namely:-

“22A. Act to be in addition to any other law.- The provisions of this Act shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other law for the time being in force and nothing contained herein shall exempt any public servant from any proceedings which might apart from this Act, be instituted against him.”

13. Insertion of new section 24 A.- After section 24 of the Principal Act the following new section shall be inserted, namely.-

“24A. The Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 to apply subject to certain modifications.- Section 19 of the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 (Central Act 49 of 1988) shall have effect as if after sub-section (2) the following sub-section had been inserted, namely:-

“(2A) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-sections (1) and (2), in relation to offences referred to in sub-section (1) investigated by police officers working in the office of the Lokayukta who is appointed under the

Karnataka Lokayukta Act 1984 (Karnataka Act 4 of 1985),
the previous sanction shall be of that Lokayukta.”

14. Validation.- Notwithstanding anything contained in any judgment, decree or order of any court, any action taken by the Lokayukta under the Principal Act, prior to the commencement of this Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been taken under the Principal Act as amended by this Ordinance and no such action including investigation, proceedings, enquiry or recommendation made thereon shall be deemed to be invalid by reason only that, at the time when such action was taken, the Lokayukta had no powers to take such action under the Principal Act and no jurisdiction exercised by the Lokayukta under the Principal Act shall be called in question before any court, authority or tribunal.

(2) Sub-section (3) of section 4 shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 1st day of April, 2002 and the remaining provisions shall come into force at once.
