ORDER

In "The New Indian Express" – daily newspaper dated 26-07-2019, a news item with a title **"These kids trek 24 Km on forest track to school and back"** has been published high-lighting the difficulties faced by the students who live in the remote forest area. Instead of repeating the contents of the news item published, it is useful to extract the same, which reads as here under:

"GOING to school has become a risky affair for children of Chapoli, Kapoli, Mudai and adjoining villages located inside the Khanapur forest. With no bus facility to reach their school in Jamboti – located in the midst of dense forest – the children have no choice but to walk for 25 km each day to go to school and return home.

And with the onset of the monsoon, the stretch has turned muddy causing more hardship to the children. The children, however, are sometimes dropped to school by the forest department personnel in their patrolling vehicles.

Khanapur forest is home to several endangered species and man-animal conflict is common in

the region. Villagers have been attacked by leopard, bears and other wild animals in the past. Residents of Chapoli, Kapoli, Mudgi, Varakad-Patye and Amgaon have been demanding amenities like good roads, power supply, education for their children and health services for many years. Speaking to TNIE, Vyankat Patil, a resident of Chapoli, recalled that villager had even boycotted the recent Lok Sabha elections to draw attention of the government towards their problems. Following heavy rain, the road which leads to Chapoli from Jamboti has turned from bad to worse, due to which the KSRTC suspended bus services to the village.

Chapoli has a school which provides education from Class 1 to 5. However, for classes 6 to 10, children have to travel 12 km to reach Jamboti. The High Court on December 24, 2014, had instructed the state government to provide all basic facilities to 20 villages located in Khanapur jungles which included Chapoli and Kapoli.

A report on the fund required for the development works has been forwarded to the government and the latter is yet to respond. Only after the government takes a final call on it, works in these 20 villages will be taken up”.

2. The news item extracted above, high-lights the problem of the young children who walk in dense forest covering about 24 Kms., every day to go to the school and return to their residences. The news item also high-lights

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that, on certain occasions, the officials of the Forest Department use their patrolling vehicles to help the students to reach the school and back, where ever it is possible. While the grace shown by the officials of Forest Department is appreciable, the students cannot be made to depend upon the grace of the officials of Forest Department without providing regular transport service.

3. It is needless to point out that, Right to Education is a Fundamental Right guaranteed under Article 21-A of the Constitution of India and Right to free and compulsory education guaranteed under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009. Therefore, it is the duty of the authorities of the state to provide all the facilities required to make the Right to Education guaranteed under Article 21-A of the Constitution of India and Right to free and compulsory education guaranteed under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, meaningful and purposeful, without making it as only a dead letter in the statute. The news item indicates that repeated representations were made to

the authorities concerned and the local people also had boycotted the last Lok Sabha elections. These things should have immediately attracted the attention of the authorities concerned and they should have taken immediate steps either by establishing educational institutions very close to the students' population, if possible, or at least, transport facilities. It is needless to point out that, whenever the buses are introduced or transport facilities are provided by the State, it is not looked into or examined only from the point of earning profit or income to the State or its authorities, but it is looked into from the point of providing facilities to the travelling public, more particularly to the young school going children and the women.

4. It is needless to point out that it is also the duty of the officers of KSRTC to make an assessment of the need of the travelling public in providing transport facilities in a particular area wherever it is lacking. If what has appeared in the news item extracted above is correct, it only shows that there has not been any conscious effort made by the



authorities of the NWKRTC (North Western Karnataka Road Transport Corporation) to assess the need of the travelling public in providing transport facility. The news item also indicates that the Chief Executive Officer of Zilla Panchayat, Belagavi also had sent a report to the Government about the problems faced by the school going children.

5. The news item extracted above clearly indicates that the authorities of the State had failed in their duties to provide required/minimum facilities to the students to attend the school. Hence, it has to be treated as **'mal-administration'** within the meaning of Section 2(10) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act, 1984, on the part of the concerned officers/authorities of the State.

6. It is needless to point out that the long distance of travel would seriously affect the academic curriculum of the students. Therefore, it is the duty of the authorities of the State to provide all the facilities to the students to get qualitative education and create an atmosphere congenial to them to study the subjects.



7. In my view, the news item published in "The New Indian Express" can be considered as source material for me to exercise my suo-moto power under Sections 7(1)(b) and 9(3)(a) of the Karnataka Lokayukta Act, 1984. Accordingly, I hereby exercise my suo-moto power and initiate suo-moto proceedings. The office is directed to register this proceeding as suo-moto proceeding.

8. For the purpose of investigation/enquiry, I am of the view, that it would be in the interest of justice to implead the following officers of the State as Respondents and **direct the notice** to them:

9. It is also needless to point out that the authorities concerned would immediately take steps to provide transport facilities to the school going children. The children also cannot be exposed themselves to severe sun, rain and attack by the wild animals and also by the ferocious dogs.
10. The officers referred to above are directed to examine the issues high-lighted in the news item and submit their comments/action taken report, within four weeks from the date of communication of this order.



11. Communicate this order to the Superintendent of Police, Karnataka Lokayukta, Belagavi, for information and redressal of the grievance through concerned authorities.

12. On the next date of hearing, the Deputy Director of Public Instructions, Belagavi and representatives of NWKRTC are directed to be present along with the status report.

This is a suo-motu proceedings. Sri. Prasanna Kumar K. Balanaik, Chief Law Officer, NWKRTC, Hubli is present along with Sri. M.R.Munji, Divisional Controller, NWKRTC, Belagavi and Sri H.Ramanagouda, Divisional Traffic Officer, NWKRTC, Belagavi.

2. Sri K.S.Nander, Deputy Project Coordinator, Office of the DDPI, Belagavi is present along with Smt. V.H.Bereger, Block Education Officer, Khanapur and Sri A.R.Ambigi, Block Resource Coordinator, Office of the BEO, Khanapur.

3. A status report is filed on behalf of 6th respondent, the Managing Director, NWKRTC. It is useful to extract the said report, which reads as hereunder:

"BEFORE THE HON'BLE KARNATAKA LOKAYUKTA, BENGALURU

Subject : Complaint published in "The New Indian Express" on 29-7-2019 regarding providing Transportation facilities to Chapoli Village-reg.



With reference to the above subject, it is to submit your kind information that a complaint is published in "The New Indian Express" on 29-7-2019 regarding providing transportation facilities to Chapoli, Kapoli & Mudagai Villages of Khanapur Taluka. Hence, status report is taken and details are as below :

1. In respect of above said villages, the Chapoli village is 25 Kms. away from Khanapur, from Jamboti 7 Kms and Mudagai/Kapoli cross the distance is 4 Kms. Like wise from Kapoli village to Mudagai/Kapoli cross 1.5 Kms and Mudagai village is 2.5 Kms away. To these three villages one bus in the morning at 8.30 and other in the evening at 17.30 were plying (Schedule No.64 & 74) from Khanapur to Chapoli via Jamboti Mudagai/Kapoli cross. (Copy of the Form -IV is placed at Annexure 'A').

2. The said Chapoli village is situated in thick forest area. From Mudagai/Kapoli cross to Chapoli it is reserved forest area. Due to heavy rain in the recent past the connected roads are not motor-able and this is the situation of every year and this year is even more. Hence, the transport facility is hampering due to heavy rain.

3. In the month of June-2019 on account of heavy rain and because of the same the roads are non- motor-able from Kapoli/Mudagai cross to Chapoli for a distance of 4 Kms., it is state that the operation of buses were temporarily suspended till 10-6-2019. The buses were operating to Kapoli/Mudagai cross till 3-8-2019 when it was stopped as roads were non-motor-able. (Copies of conductor way bills and log sheets of the drivers are placed at Annexure 'B').

4. In respect of complaint published in the news paper regarding inconvenience of essential services and also transportation facility to the above said villages, the Divisional Traffic Officer, NWKRTC, Belagavi Division alongwith Depot Manager Khanapur have personally conducted route survey and have reported the road is not motor-able and supportingly have produced related videos and further visited personally before the Lokayukta Office at Belagavi and narrated the facts. (Videos are placed at Annexure 'C').



5. In the month of August – 2019 at Belagavi District due to heavy rain/flood majority of villages of Khanapur Taluka are surrounded with water and transport facility was stopped. On account of damages/deterioration of bridge situated near Shankarpeth on Malaprabha river, connectivity to Talevadi / Chapoli / Kapoli / Amatha / Kanakumbi/ Parawad/Chikala and Chigula villages was hampered and operation of buses was suspended. There is a very old bridge built by stones and it is in deterioration condition and to avoid untoward incidents the use of this road is prohibited and a letter to that effect is written by the Asst. Executive Engineer, PWD and Inland & Water Transport Dept., sub-division, Khanapur to the Tahashildar, Khanapur seeking to issue directions to stop movements of all vehicles on the said road.(Copy of the letter is placed at Annexure 'D').

6. The stating that the Chapoli village road is non-motorable and apprising the same, letters to the Chief Executive Engineer, Zilla Panchayath, Belagavi & Executive Engineer, Panchayath Raj Engineering Division Belagavi are written and have requested to make motorable road to Chapoli village (Copies of the letters are placed at Annexure 'E').

7. As stated before, the transport facility to Chapoli village are temporarily suspended due to unavoidable circumstances and there is no any ill-intention of the Corporation for the inconvenience caused to them, it is all because of natural calamities.

In the light of the above, NWKRTC is looking forwarded to ply the buses as soon as possible in the said Routes.

5. The Officers referred to above have jointly submitted that, since the road in question, ^{and} a bridge have been completely damaged on account of rain and floods, NWKRTC is compelled to stop operation of the bus facility with a view to avoid any untoward incident to the members of the public and more particularly children. While I appreciate the steps, which were taken to stop operation of busses on the route in question on account of the bad condition of the road and collapsed bridge, it

is needless to point out that, it is the duty of the authorities to take immediate steps to repair the road and to reconstruct the bridge. It is admitted by them that, the area in question falls within the reserved forest. These are the matters required to be examined by the Respondents 3 & 4. Sri Nander submits that, he has been instructed to represent the Chief Executive Officer and the Deputy Commissioner as they are held up in flood relief work.

6. The ARLO-3 to go through the report and submit scrutiny note **within a week from today.** In the meanwhile Sri Nander submitted that, he has already taken steps to admit 28 boys, who are studying in the pre-metric school to Jamboti Social Welfare Hostel and they will be admitted within a week from today. He further submitted that 50 girls who are studying in the pre-metric school will be admitted to the Social Welfare Pre-metric Hostel at Khanapura within a week from today. The said statement made by Sri Nander is placed on record. **He is instructed to submit a status report**

within 10 days from today with regard to the admission of the students referred to above in the Social Welfare Hostels *and the schools* It is the duty of the Officers concerned to persuade the parents of the students with regard to the importance of the education and the measure that is being taken by the department is in the interest of their children.

7. **In the light of what is stated above, the authorities are directed to submit the status report with regard to the steps taken to repair the road in question and reconstruct the collapsed bridge within three months from today.**

FURTHER SCRUTINY NOTE

3. It is respectfully submitted that, this note is put up in compliance of the order dated 30/08/2019.
4. The Superintendent of Police, Karnataka Lokayukta, Belagavi has submitted report dated 23/08/2019 stating that Chapoli village is situated at a distance of 30 Km from Khanapura and 12 Km from Jamboti. Kapoli village is situated at a distance of 6 Km from Jamboti. The road connecting these places is located in a dense reserve forest which has been damaged due to flow of water and its stagnation in the pot holes. The report also indicates that the Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Panchayath, Belagavi had submitted report dated 19/12/2017 to the Principal Secretary to the Government, RDPR for formation of roads within the limits of District. However, no proposal for formation of the road in question was sent by him. The I.O. has opined that due to heavy rain the road in question is not fit for use by vehicles.

5. The Chief Law Officer on behalf of respondent no.6 has submitted report on 30/08/2019 during the course of proceedings. The said report indicates that the road from Chapoli village is not a motarable road and that letters have been addressed to the Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Panchayath, Belagavi on 19 & 20/08/2019 requesting him for formation of motarable roads to connect the said village through bus facility.
6. The respondent no.8 has also submitted a report on 30/08/2019 during the course of proceedings. The said report contains the statistics with respect to the students population studying in 8th, 9th and 10th class at Government school in Jamboti coming from surrounding 13 villages. From Chapoli village there are two male students studying 8th class and one female student studying in 9th class. From Kapoli village there are three male and four female students studying 8th class and six male and four female students studying in 9th class whereas there is one male student and two female students studying in 10th class. None of the above mentioned students are travelling to the school by bus, but five of them reside in the boys hostel. As an enclosure with the said report a letter dated 13/08/2019 addressed by the DDPI, Belagavi to the State Project Director, Comprehensive Education Unit

Karnataka, Bengaluru has been submitted which indicates that, a request for release of funds to provide transport facility to 56 students studying at Khanapura Range has been made.

7. Considering the contents of the above report , apart from seeking report in compliance of the order dated 30/08/2019, it would be proper to inform the Chief Executive Officer, Zilla Panchayath, Belagavi to submit action taken report on the letters dated 19/08/2019 and 20/08/2019 addressed to him by the Divisional Controller, NWKRTC, Belagavi. Likewise the State Project Director, Comprehensive Education Unit of Karnataka, Bengaluru may also be informed to submit action taken report on the letter dated 13/08/2019 addressed to him by DDPI, Belagavi.



29. Subsequently the CEO, ZP, Belagavi has submitted report dated 28/11/2019 which indicates that in order to form all weather durable road from Chapoli, Kapoli and Mudagai villages, the concordance of Forest Department is required as the area proposed for construction of road falls within the limits of reserve forest area. However an estimate for construction of such road at an estimated cost of Rs. One Crore has been prepared and submitted to the Principal Secretary RDPR. Though a copy of the estimate for construction of such road is enclosed with the report but the copy of the letter addressed to the Principal Secretary and the letter addressed to officials of forest department for providing sanction are not

submitted by CEO, ZP. Therefore it would be proper to inform the CEO, ZP, Belagavi to submit copies of the documents mentioned above so as to secure further action taken report from the concerned.



It is respectfully submitted that, the Executive Engineer, Project Division, Belagavi has submitted report dtd.05/12/2020 stating that on approval of estimate for formation of road to Chapoli Village of Khanapura Taluk, the work has been commenced. 





53. It is respectfully submitted that, the Executive Engineer, Project Division, Karnataka Rural Development Institution, Belagavi has submitted report dtd.12/02/2021 stating that through letter dtd.03/02/2021 the Conservator of Forest, Belagavi Zone and the Conservator of Forest, Khanapura Zone have been informed about the existence of road between Chapoli village till Jamboti by enclosing photographs of the same. On receipt of permission from Forest Department further action for improvement of road in question would be taken. Similarly it is reported that through letter dtd.28/01/2021 the Deputy Conservator of Forest was also informed about the road in question by enclosing relevant record.
54. 
